### **IN THE CHANCEL**

- Colours of the 173rd Battalion, Canadian Highlanders Canadian Expeditionary Force (C.E.F.) World War I.
- Communion Table, gift of H. O. Bain and his wife Ethel Hagar.
- Carved oak mirror frame, placed in memory of J. Albert Smyth by his wife Margaret Smyth Liddell.
- Cassavant organ and chimes presented by the women of MacNab in memory of H. Maude Ketchen in 1947.
- Brass lectern, placed by Mrs. Howard Richards in memory of Mr. and Mrs. John E. Hemingway.

### **IN THE SANCTUARY**

- Handbells and cabinet, in memory of Russell S. Reid.

### **IN THE NARTHEX**

- Bronze tablet and memorial volume honouring the memory of the Officers and Men of the 173rd Battalion, Canadian Highlanders.
- Tower clock dedicated in 1977 by Margaret A. Reid in memory of her parents Mr. and Mrs. John H. MacBean.
- Oak furnishings, in memory of Edna Currie, Frank Milne and Henrietta Brass.
