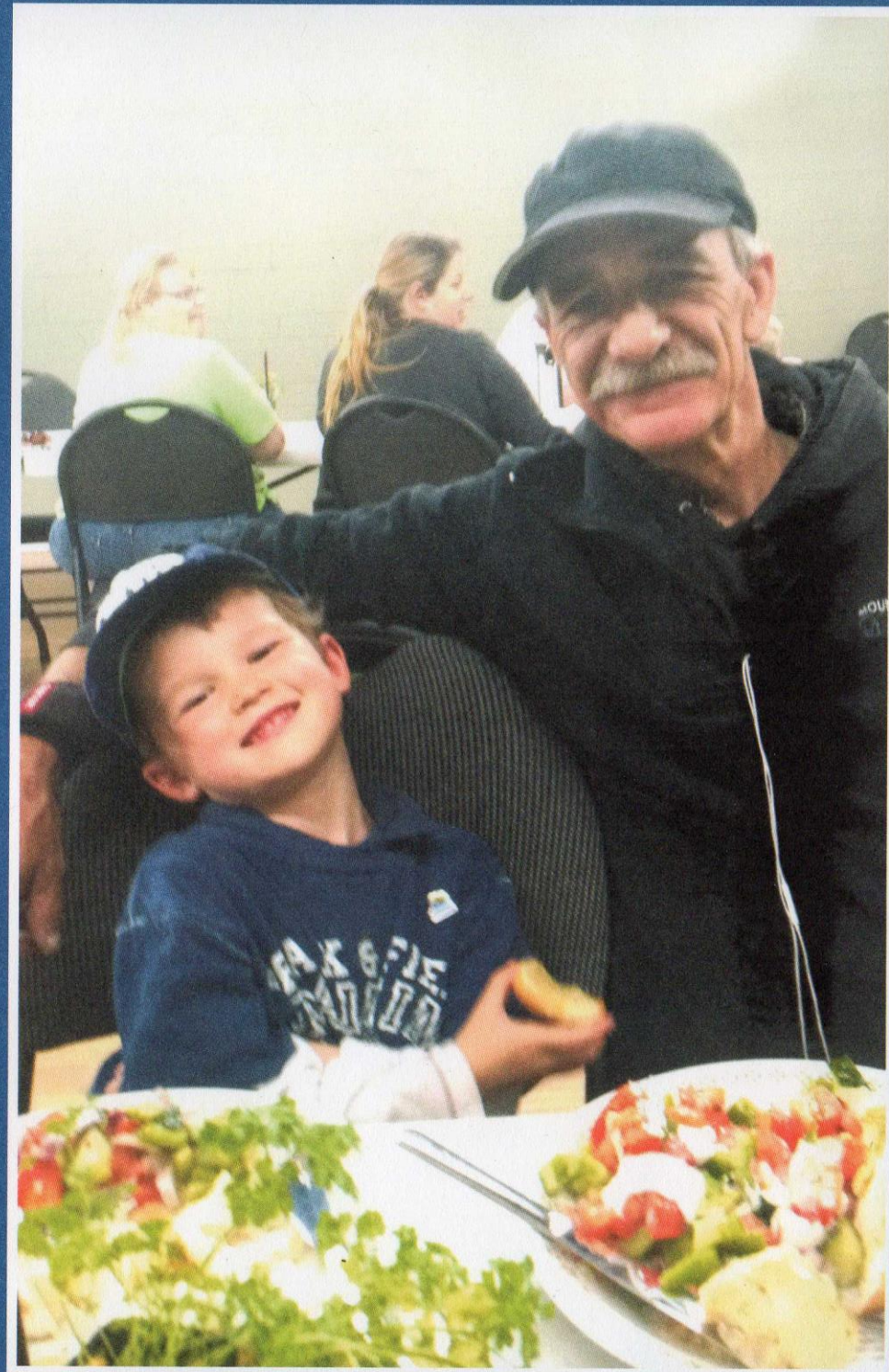
살다보면 겉으로 보이는 것이 전부가 아니라는 것을
