WELCOME TO MACNAB!

Thank you for taking the time to worship this morning at MacNab.

Are you a first-time visitor? Please plan to join us following the service for coffee in Johnston Hall - when you exit the sanctuary, turn left and follow the aroma!

Do you have children? They are invited to join us at the front part way through our service for our "children's time". Following this, children will go to "KidZone" (takes place in the Parlour). Children will re-enter the Sanctuary at the POSTLUDE and parents can pick up their children at the front of the sanctuary as soon as POSTLUDE is completed. We also ask that (except for CHILDREN'S TIME AND "KidZone") you keep your child in your care (never wandering unsupervised), including accompanying them to the washroom if the need arises. Infants are most welcome to remain with parents throughout the service – and fussing babies are music to our ears and a sign of a healthy growing church! This includes new children who may not yet be comfortable going to "KidZone." Change tables are located in both the ladies' and men's washrooms adjacent to Johnston Hall.

UPDATE ON BREAKFAST OUTREACHES AT MACNAB

For the past two years, MacNab has offered holiday weekend breakfast outreaches that have been a blessing to the hundreds who have attended, including the volunteers. Recently, we conducted both a written and open meeting evaluation of these

outreaches. For the most part, we agree that the outreaches should continue with a few modifications.

- 1 We require that more volunteers sign up/ commit to the event in advance. In an effort to ease the burden on organizers to mobilize volunteers we will be asking for commitments in advance.
- 2. We will no longer receive grant funding for this initiative. Because the breakfasts are now part of our "ministry fabric", we cannot continue to rely on start up grants previously raised. Each breakfast event costs approximately \$500-600. Anyone who wishes to contribute \$5 over and above their normal offerings to help offset costs, can simply include it with their regular offering, indicating the amount to be allocated to "breakfasts".
- 3. Frequency of the outreaches will be modified if necessary, depending on how things unfold with 1-2 above.

In light of these modifications, sign up lists for our Family Day Breakfast Outreach on **Monday**, **February 19**th will be available starting **TODAY**, **December 24**th **through to Sunday February 4**th. All those who plan to serve/ participate are asked to visit the sign-up table and make a commitment by February 4th. Here is a list of the number of helpers we need:
